DAY 2:

- 10:30 am – "Shopping in Laredo." Tour of Laredo's shops as appropriate, with or without a guide.
- 12:00 hrs – Boat trip and tasting of Cantabrian anchovies (a delicatessen) and a drink. In case of bad weather, this tour will take place on a terrace or in a landscaped garden.
- 13:00 hrs – Visit to the Pejinas canning factory.
- 14:00 hrs – Typical Laredo lunch at one of these restaurants.
- 16:00 hrs – End of the trip.

DAY 1:

- 10:00 am – Arrival at the Innovation Center to watch a video about the history of Laredo and La Puebla Vieja, as well as a brief description of the visit and the route to follow.
- 11:00 am – Start of the tour of La Puebla Vieja.
- 12:00 hrs – Lunch stop: snacks and drinks.
- 12:30 hrs – Continuation of the tour of La Puebla Vieja.
- 13:00 hrs – Visit to the Puerta de San Lorenzo... "Laredo, a fishing, military, royal, and international commercial port in the 16th century." Its importance and relationship with Northern Europe. The Hanseatic League.
- 14:00 hrs – Lunch at a restaurant in Laredo.
- 16:00 hrs – Free time.
- 17:00 hrs – Visit to the Church of Santa María de la Asunción (Proto-Gothic. National Monument. 13th-16th centuries). "The Bethlehem Altarpiece." An excellent example of 15th-century Brussels sculpture in Europe.
- 18:30 hrs – Arrival at the hotel and rest of the day at leisure.
